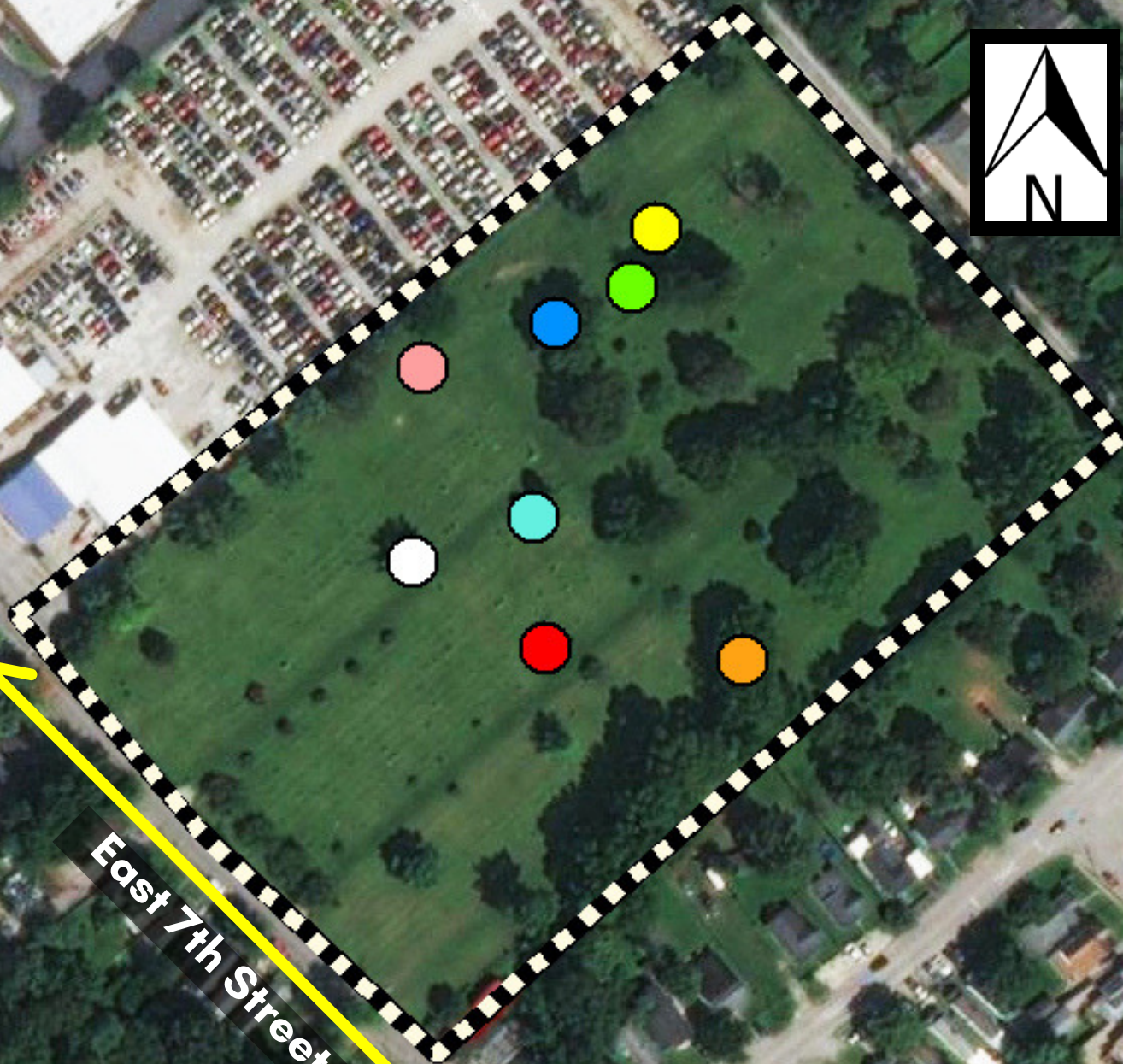

(*Juglans nigra*)



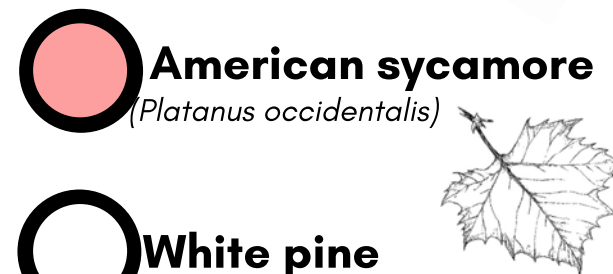
Redbud
(*Cercis canadensis*)



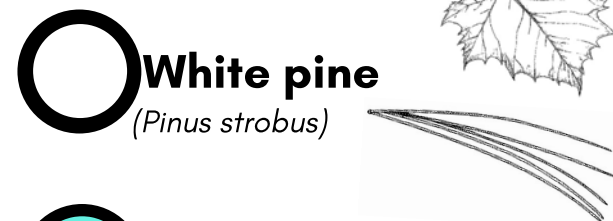
Black cherry
